ASSIGNMENT:

This assignment was e-mailed to our office on February 18, 2008 requesting that we inspect bus # 1906.

IDENTIFICATION:

The damaged unit is identified as a 2004 Gillig Passenger Bus bearing VIN # 15GGD291641074431. The unit shows average wear and tear for its age. At the time of our inspection, the unit had 115,195 miles.

INSPECTION:

We inspected the unit on February 18, 2008. Our inspection revealed damage to the front bumper, right side and rear bumper of the unit. We did not see any other area of damage at the time of our inspection.

DAMAGES:

We have attached our estimate of damages in the amount of \$9,351.92. Please note that there may be additional damages once a tear down is completed. We have

requested to be called if there are additional damages that are not included in our estimate.

Our estimate is for the repair and replacement of the damaged areas to the front bumper, right side and rear bumper. Please note that there were no used parts available, therefore; all estimated replacement parts are new.
